






Background

- Approximately 94 staff managing the caseload.
 Ratio of 1:74
- Comprised of Parole Officers, <u>Community</u>
 <u>Corrections Case Managers</u> and Community
 Corrections Agents
 - Program Managers, Training, Special Investigator and Admin Support (16)
- Specialized Caseloads: Drug Court, Mental Health, Women, Young Adults, Parole, Sex Offense, Domestic Violence, Interstate Compact (Out).


Challenges

- High Caseload
 - Young Adults: 41% end in revocation
 - Native Americans: 47% end in revocation
 - Women: 34% end in revocation
 - Addiction and Mental Health needs
- Keeping up with technology
- Culture of risk aversion decision-making
- Culture that sensationalizes crime
 - Stigma
- Recruitment, Retention & Care of Highly Trained Professionals

- Greater emphasis on staff engaging and motivating people towards change (teaching & coaching).
