- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 16.1-06-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to fraud countermeasures on ballots; and to provide an effective date.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. Section 16.1-06-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and

5 enacted as follows:

- 6 <u>16.1-06-04.1. Fraud countermeasures for ballots.</u>
- 7 <u>1.</u> Except for local elections, each official ballot prepared under this title must include all
  8 <u>of the following fraud countermeasures:</u>
- 9a.Unique, controlled-supply, watermarked clearing bank specification 1 security10paper;
- 11 <u>b.</u> <u>Secure holographic foil that acts as a visual deterrent and anti-copy feature;</u>
- 12c.Branded overprint of any hologram that personalizes the hologram with a13customer logo;
- 14 <u>d.</u> <u>Custom, complex security background designs with banknote-level security;</u>
- 15 <u>e.</u> <u>Secure variable digital infill;</u>
- 16 <u>f.</u> <u>Thermochromic, tri-thermochromic, photochromic, or optically variable inks;</u>
- 17 g. Stealth numbering in ultraviolet, infrared, or taggant inks;
- 18 <u>h.</u> <u>Multicolored, micronumismatic, invisible, ultraviolet designs;</u>
- 19 <u>i.</u> <u>Unique forensic fraud detection technology built into security inks; and</u>
- 20 j. Unique barcode or quick response code accessible only to the voter which tracks
  21 the voter's ballot as the ballot is processed.
- 22 <u>2. Except for local elections, a vendor of ballots prepared under this title must be certified</u>
- 23 as compliant with standard ISO 27001, ISO 17025, or ISO 9001:2015 of the
- 24 international organization for standardization.
