Provide an explanation as to how the request supports state priorities, improves state efficiencies, and promotes effective state government:

The services NDIT provides to our customers include network connectivity, application hosting services, cybersecurity, end user compute support and many others. These services provide support to their state priorities. Having the necessary resources available to provide those services is crucial. Not having spending authority to replace faulty equipment or maintain support agreements will cause service interruptions to our customers. In some cases, if vendor support agreements lapse, the vendor will require a penalty fee be paid to reinstate support. This would not be efficient use of the funds appropriated to us.



Provide any other relevant information:

At the time the 67th Legislative body set NDIT's appropriation limits, it could not be known that the country would see inflationary rates that hit a 40-year high. Vendors are taking increases in all areas of IT from equipment to software to professional services they provide. OMB Fiscal and Administrative Policy 202 which pertains to NDCC54-44.1-03 Section 5 and NDCC54-27-10 which reserves 25 percent of agency budgets for salaries and operating expenses for the last six months of a biennium. The ask for additional appropriation will allow NDIT to maintain current levels of operations within these rules.
