Provide explanation:

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021 has created federal funding opportunities for state to apply for. One such opportunity is the Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program (BEAD)- Planning Grant. This BEAD - Planning Grant is intended to fund a planning exercise whereby a statewide comprehensive broadband program crafted specifically for the unique needs of ND. This plan is a prerequisite for the larger BEAD program which is a formula grant. This future grant provides for the ability to ensure that all ND citizens have access to high-speed broadband as well as promote the digital equity, support digital inclusion, and build capacity for efforts by States relating to the adoption of broadband by residents of ND. Access challenges are prioritized over digital equity in this grant. NDIT has applied for and will be awarded \$5M of federal funds for the planning activities related to this program.

Will funding be required in future bienniums? Yes

Provide explanation:

Future grant award under the Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program is a formula grant that includes a minimum of \$100M with additional dollars based on a formula based on a broadband map that is currently under construction by the FCC. The planning dollars are included within the \$100M which provides an opportunity for a minimum of \$95M of additional federal funding.

Does the request conform with legislative intent? No

Provide explanation:

While there has not been any ND legislation to date establishing intent, each State is eligible to apply for grants under this program. The Governor or equivalent official of an applicant State shall select an Administering Entity to receive and administer the State's grant funding. NDIT has been selected as the Administering Entity of the State's grant funding.

Provide an explanation as to how the request supports state priorities, improves state efficiencies, and promotes effective state government:

In recent decades, access to the internet has played a critical and growing role in the ways in which North Dakota residents work, learn, receive health care, earn a living, and participate in democracy. The COVID-19 pandemic crystalized what many have known for a very long time: High-speed internet access is not a luxury, but a necessity, for all North Dakota residents regardless of their age, race, or income, irrespective of where they live, what languages they speak, what resources they have at their disposal, and what challenges they may face in their daily lives. This funding opportunity is intended to identify any access issues that remain and come to resolution on access issue first. Secondarily what barriers to adoption are within North Dakota and help determine what actions should be taken to overcome those barriers to adoption and help enable all residents to become full participants in a digital society and a digital world.
