This transfer is to account for the additional pandemic-related federal funding for school district grants. During the first half of the biennium, we received approximately \$70 million more than expected for the School Nutrition and Child Care programs funded by the US Department of Agriculture. The remaining \$5 million was from increases to existing US Department of Education programs. The line we are transferring from contains funding for ESSER I, II, and III with the majority of the funds expiring in September 2024. We will not be using all of the funds in this line during the 2021-23 biennium.
