Minutes: <u>Rep. Maragos</u>: Introduced bill 1204, to provide for a state-owned airline, relating to administrative agencies and to provide a continuing appropriation. The bill came about due to the airline strike in ND.

<u>Rep. Thorpe</u>: Is there any Federal money that could help investigate and support this idea? <u>Rep. Maragos</u>: We have had competition introduced into ND at the request of congressional intervention. If we showed a need to our congressional delegation they could find some money to help us study this matter and find some other alternatives to this situation in the future. <u>Chairman Berg</u>: We know the problems this created. What can we do as a legislative body to prevent any future problems, and be in a better situation than before? <u>Rep. Maragos</u>: This is the challenge that I've put before you.

#### **Opposition to bill 1204.**

J.B. Lindquist: Opposes bill. This could be very costly to the state.

### PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1204

Page 1, line 1, after "A BILL" replace the remainder of the bill with "for an Act to provide for air service contracts.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Industrial commission authorization of air service contracts by aeronautics commission. Upon request of the industrial commission, after a determination by the industrial commission that air service to this state has been or will be interrupted and the interruption is causing or will cause a serious economic impact on this state or an impact on the safety of the residents of this state, the aeronautics commission may contract for temporary air service to and from this state. The director of aeronautics shall develop and update a plan for the contracting in cooperation with the tourism department, the department of economic development and finance, and other appropriate agencies. The director shall present the plan to the industrial commission."
