Sponsor: Representatives Sandvig, Rose, Kliniske; Senators DeMers, Lee, Thane

Affected Retirement Program: Uniform group insurance program

**Proposal:** Provides that the Public Employees Retirement System Board shall provide medical benefits coverage for annual physical examinations for women.

**Actuarial Analysis:** The actuarial consultant reported that based upon the assumption that an annual physical examination means an office call, the estimated annual cost of the proposal would be \$240,000.

Committee Report: Unfavorable recommendation.
