Summary of bill: Relates to the State Board of Agricultural Research.

Rep Nowatzki: This bill would amend and reenact section 4-05.1-19 of the North Dakota

Century Code, relating to the state board of agricultural research. It specifcally states in section 8 the Agricultural research board shall annually evaluate the progress toward investing a sum equal to two percent of gross farm income in research and extension and report the findings to the legislative council and the state board of higher education.

<u>Roger Johnson</u>: Commissioner of Agriculture.. Very significant that this came out of the council study that at least 2% minimal should be invested in research and extension work. What this bill really does is very simple, it simply adds another responsiblty to S-Bar charge of evaluating and reporting back to the producer what it is doing.
