



He indicated to the committee that the resolution has some amendments added to it which change the number of short stories and movies that have been made of Louis L'Amour's writing and he asks the committees support of the resolution. Appearing before the committee was CHARLIE KOURAJIAN, Mayor of Jamestown, he indicated there is a real active group in Jamestown that's promoting Louis L'Amour. They are headed by Reese and Margaret Hawken. Their primary object right now is to get Louis L'Amour on a postage stamp. For those of you that don't know, you have to be dead 10 years before you can even be considered for a postage stamp. It's almost worse than the
