SENATOR WANZEK opened the hearing on HCR 3051. Committee members present included: Sens. Wanzek, Klein, Sand, Urlacher, Kinnoin, Kroeplin, and D. Mathern.

REPRESENTATIVE LEROY BERNSTEIN, DISTRICT 45 introduced HCR 3051. I feel we should take a look at this to see why we are losing all of our producers and why is it costing over \$2 million a year for our consumers (read a letter).

SENATOR SAND Transportation is a huge factor and there are taxes there. The regulations are also part of the spread. With the cattle and dairy farmers down from 1900 to 700, is the volume the same?

REPRESENTATIVE BERNSTEIN Somewhat, the ones left behind got bigger and the smaller ones dropped out. It is down somewhat.
