TESTIMONY FOR HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 3061 PREPARED BY REPRESENTATIVE MERLE BOUCHER WEDNESDAY, MARCH 10, 1999

Chairman Urlacher and member of the Senate Finance and Tax Committee for the record I am Representative Merle Boucher, from District 9, which is all of Rolette Country.

There is considerable concern amongst the citizens of North Dakota regarding the structure of our states tax system(s). Many are saying that the existing structure is out of balance and that there is a disparity amongst which of our citizens face paying the bulk of the tax burden.

We all know there is much concern regarding property taxes at the local level. Many citizens are saying that property owners are shouldering a disproportionate share of the states share of the state's tax burden. HCR 3061 recommends that a statewide study of tax types, tax assessments, and tax systems be studied during the interim.
