SENATOR FREBORG opened the hearing on SB2146, A BILL RELATING TO PAYMENT OF STATE SCHOOL AID BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION. Eileen Holwegner, fiscal officer for the Fiscal Management Division of the Office of

Management and Budget testified in favor of SB2146.

SENATOR O'CONNELL: Do you make the payments now or do they certify and then you make the payments. Clear that up for me?

Eileen: At the present time the Department of Public Instruction processes all the payments to the school districts, foundation aid and the tuition apportionment. They do it through the states accounting system which produces an abstract for payment and the superintendent or the Dept. of Public Instruction approves the abstract, it is a form that goes on to OMB and Page 2 Senate Education Committee Bill/Resolution Number Sb2146 Hearing Date January 6, 1999

OMB releases the abstract into funding accounting system in order for the payment to be released.. So basically the Dept. of Education is processing the payments and making the payments to the school districts. But it is truly OMB's accounting system.

SENATOR WANZEK : What you are saying was this will actually clean it up so that is actually what is being done now.

Eileen: Yes we want it to read the way it is being done now. This is language that is many years old and at one time a lot of the payments were made by OMB. But right now all school aid payments are being processed like any other expenditure an agency has and is made through their department. Would like to correct the law to agree to practice.

SENATOR FREBORG : Anyone here to testify in opposition to SB2146 Very good we will close the hearing on SB2146.

Mr. Chairman and members of the committee,

My name is Eileen Holwegner. I am the fiscal officer for the Fiscal Management Division of the Office of Management and Budget. OMB is introducing Senate Bill 2146 to clean up outdated language in sections 15-40.1-05 and 15-44-03 of the North Dakota Century Code in regard to state school aid payments. The current language in these sections of century code states that the Office of Management and Budget shall pay the state school aid payments upon certification from the Superintendent of Public Instruction. The Department of Public Instruction is making the foundation aid and tuition apportionment payments to school districts through the statewide accounting system. This bill changes the language in the century code to state that the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall make the state school aid payments.
