Minutes: CHAIRMAN KREBSBACH opened the hearing on SB 2219. The bill relates to the filing of proposed administrative rules with the legislative council. SENATOR BOB STENEHJEM primary sponsor of the bill introduced the bill to the committee. He indicated that this was a very simple bill. This bill deals with administrative rules. What this bill would simply do is that at the time they propose to make a new administrative rule that they need to file a copy of the proposed rule with the legislative council. If anyone wanted to know about a new proposed administrative rule, they could call the council and get the information they need including a copy of the proposed rule. Basically that is all this law would do. Also appearing in support of this bill was REPRESENTATIVE BERNSTEIN. He simply reiterated that he supports this proposed piece of legislation. KEN BERTSCH, representing the North Dakota Farm Bureau appeared before the committee to indicate that his organization supports SB 2219. There were no questions offered from the committee. No further testimony was offered in

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2219. There was no testimony in neutral position or in opposition to SB 2219. The hearing was closed on SB 2219. SENATOR W. NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Secretary of State will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendment in North Dakota Administrative Code Section 72-01-02-07 (4). The hearing will be held on February 15, 1999, at 2:00 p.m., in the office of the Secretary of State, First Floor, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to remove the requirement for the debtor's signature on a continuation statement filed under the Central Notice Filing System. The Packers and Stockyard Administration of the United States Department of Agriculture has amended its federal regulations, effective January 4, 1999, to provide that continuation statements filed on Central Notice System Effective Financing Statements do not need a signature of the debtor.

The proposed new rule is not expected to have in impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
