Minutes:

Hearing opened on SB2296.

Testimony in Favor: Senator Mutzenberger, Bismarck.

Testimony in Favor: Representative Hoffner, District 32. Why do we always have to pass the foundation aid too late in the session. So that is what this bill is all about. This looks at the first year only, so we would determine what that foundation aid payment would be for next year.

Early March would be ideal. Determine 1st year payment out so it can be passed right away. If you want to add more it can be readjusted in the 2nd payment. If you want to blend it into another bill that is all right.

SENATOR FREBORG : What is reasoning for having the bill introduced in the Senate.

Representative Hoffner: Foundation aid bill is being heard in Senate Appropriations, so I want this bill to be on the same side as the department bill.

SENATOR COOK : This establishes the foundation aid for the first year. Do you feel this will give more assurance to schools out there.

SENATOR FREBORG : Thank you Representative Hoffner. Any testimony in opposition.

Testimony: Jerry Coleman, DPI. Testified on the fiscal note attached to SB2296. Froze the payment on both years.

Narrative:

This bill establishes the educational support per student amount at \$2,129.

The Executive Recommendation establishes the educational support per student amount at \$2,129 the first year of the biennium and at \$2,221 the second year. The funding level in the Executive Recommendation is \$475.9 million.

Funding at \$2,129 for both years of the biennium reduces the required funding level to \$465.1 million, or a reduction of \$10.8 million.
