Minutes: VICE CHAIRMAN FLAKOLL called the committee to order. Roll Call was taken with all members present.

VICE CHAIRMAN FLAKOLL called the hearing on HB 1236 which relates to terms of Fargo Board of Education members, and to declare an emergency.

Testimony in support of HB 1236:

REPRESENTATIVE KATHY HAWKIN, District 36, spoke on the bill. She stated this is a bill for the Fargo public schools school board to allow them to have their election with the county and city. This would change their election from April to June. The local Board would have to make some decisions as to how the terms will be run. This would start in the next election cycle. Fargo was the first school district in the state and has a separate part in NDCC because they were established before statehood. She further stated the Board members are not paid.

There was no testimony in opposition to HB 1236.

Hearing no further testimony the hearing was closed.
