Minutes: Rep. Weisz - Chairman opened the hearing on HCR 3013; A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the designation of highways in the state highway system and the county road system.

Rep. Kretschmar: For the record I represent District 28. I introduce this bill to take a look at the state and county highways systems in the state. It is kind of a companion to the other resolutions which I have introduced. I don't know if the state highway system has ever been studied in the past; if so, not recently. We as the policy making body we need to look at the highway system to see what if anything needs to be done to improve it -- to increase it or to maintain it as it is.

Certainly it is one of the key elements of life in ND. It is a key mode of transportation in the state especially with the decline of the railroads in this state. It effects every city and county in ND. In the last 23 or 4 sessions the legislature has not been reluctant to raise the gas tax to support out road system. It is time to have a good comprehensive study of our highway system.

Rep. Grumbo: (339) Have the counties done this on their own -- as to the roads in their

Rep. Kretschmar: I can only answer with some knowledge about about my own home county of McIntosh. There has been a program of developing Federal Aid roads. There is a certain amount of money available from the federal government. In our county the electorate voted on the roads on which they would spend this money. They voted a mil levy to match those funds. It is still on going and the last project has not been yet completed.

Rep. Mahoney: (571) The big difference between federal aid roads in the counties is that the county doesn't get any funds for the maintenance of these roads they build with the federal funds. There was no opposition testimony. (635) The hearing was closed.

Discussion for action HCR 3013 (1968)

Following a brief discussion; Rep. Rep. Hawken move a 'Do Pass' for HCR 3013.

Rep. Mahoney: I second the motion.

On a roll call vote the motion carried unaimously: 13 yeas 0 nays 1 absent.

Tim Horner: None really, typically it's the state and counties involved.
