Minutes: VICE CHAIRMAN FLAKOLL called the hearing on HCR 3052 which directs the Legislative Council to study issues of safety, efficiency, and cost-effectiveness with respect to school district transportation. He introduced students who were from Ellendale and Stanley, ND High Schools.

Testimony in support of HCR 3052:

REPRESENTATIVE KATHY HAWKIN, District 46, spoke in support of the bill. This is a resolution to study transportation for schools. Originally this was a bill that would have paid the same amount for mileage whether it was in-town or out-of-town bussing. This resolution will look at the financial aspects of bussing, the size of the busses, bus routes, and all the different components of school transportation.

There was no testimony in opposition to HCR 3052.

Hearing no further testimony, the hearing on HCR 3052 was closed.
