Minutes: Chairman Krebsbach opened the hearing on SB 2283 which relates to recordation of armed forces discharge papers. Representative Lonnie Winrich, District 18, a cosponsor of the bill appeared before the committee to introduce the bill. He indicated he had very little testimony to give as he assumed that Senator Bercier, primary sponsor of the bill would be present to introduce the bill. He urged favorable consideration of this bill in support of veterans of the state. Bob Hanson, Member of the Veteran's Coordinating Council and also the Legislative Committee appeared before the committee. He indicated that this is simply a housekeeping measure but he is afraid that would raise a red flag. It really is a simple bill brought to their attention by an individual who wondered why names of some of the branches of service are listed and others are not. Instead of listing them individually this bill simply puts them into generic terminology. Senator C. Nelson inquired what names we are including now. Mr. Hanson indicated to his knowledge it would be army, navy, marine corps, coast guard, air force and of course the reserves. At this time Chairman Krebsbach announced to the committee

that she would leave the hearing open on SB 2283 but would move on to SB 2284 until Senator Bercier would be able to come before the committee and speak to both bills. At this time the committee returned to SB 2283 and Senator Dennis Bercier, District 9, presented his testimony on the bill. A copy of his written testimony is attached. There were no questions from the committee at this time. The hearing on SB 2283 was closed at this time. A motion for Do Pass was made by <u>Senator T. Mathern</u>, seconded by <u>Senator Wardner</u>. Roll Call Vote indicated 6 Yeas, 0 Nays, and 0 Absent or Not Voting. <u>Senator Kilzer</u> will carry the bill.
