Minutes:

CHAIRMAN COOK called the committee to order. All members (6) were in attendance.

CHAIRMAN COOK opened the hearing on HB 1178 relating to the contents of a notice of administrative rulemaking.

John Walstad, Legislative Council, appeared neither in support or opposed to HB 1178. This bill originated with a request from the Attorney Generals Office, pointing out a couple of problems we have with the administrative rule making notice contents. When an agency begins an administrative rule making proceeding it is necessary for the agency to prepare two kinds of notice; one is what is called a full notice, which requires a greater amount of information on what the rule making will involve, an explanation of what the rules will be, a statement of whether there is going to be an impact on the regulated community of fifty thousand dollars or more, a place where interested parties can see a copy of the rule and a place where interested parties can obtain a copy. Under existing law interested parties have thirty days after the public hearing on

rules to submit written comments to the agency. The notice does not require under current law a statement of what that deadline is, the notice is to advise people that they can submit written comments, but it doesn't say that you have to have them in by this date or the agency won't accept them, so on page one of the bill with regard of the full notice, is going to have to contain a deadline saying, if you want to submit written comments they have to be into the agency by this date. The second page of the bill draft relates to the abbreviated notice of administrative rule making. This is the notice that gets published in the official county newspaper for each county in the state. About four years ago a change was made so agencies did not have to publish this full blown notice because it got expensive publishing all that information and the abbreviated notice is much shorter. It has to have a headline describing the general topic of the rules and then there is a requirement for an address and phone number. The phrasing has been changed so you do not use both the address and phone number to get a copy; you use one or the another. What the attorney general observe was missing from this is there was nothing about where to send written comments and the deadline for written comments and because most of the members of the public are going to see the newspaper notice and not the full notice, the attorney general thought it is important that they be giving an address and the deadline date has to be indicated.

No opposition to HB 1178.

CHAIRMAN COOK closed the hearing on HB 1178.
