**Senator Trenbeath**, District 10, introduced the legislation and testified in support. "It's impossible to clear books within 15 days of an auction sale considering that consignment auctions involve transactions with individuals from at least three Canadian provinces and neighboring states".

**Rep. Kasper**: Have there been complaints regarding the 15 day limit?

**Sen. Trenbeath**: People tell me that the 15 day limit is openly ignored.

**Rep. Ekstrom**: Is the overstriking on line 13 purely a housekeeping measure?

**Sen. Trenbeath**: Yes.

**Chairman Keiser**: What's the penalty for this?

**Sen. Trenbeath**: Their license can be revoked.

**Rep. Froseth**: What's the normal procedure? A partial payment back to the owner?
