"SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-09-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15.1-09-08. School district elections - Candidate filings. An individual seeking election to the board of a school district shall prepare and sign a document stating the individual's name and the position for which that individual is a candidate. A candidate shall also file a statement of interests as required by section 16.1-09-02. If the election is held in conjunction with a statewide election, these documents must be filed with the school district business manager, or mailed to and in the possession of the business manager, by four p.m. of the sixtieth day before the election. If the election is not held in conjunction with a statewide election, the document must be filed with the school district business manager, or mailed to and in the possession of the business manager, by four p.m. of the sixtieth day before the election. If the election is not held in conjunction with a statewide election, the document must be filed with the school district business manager, or mailed to and in the possession of the business manager, by four p.m. of the thirty-third sixtieth day before the election."

Section 1: Removes the text on lines 9 and 10 because it is not applicable to any existing school district situation and conflicts with other portions of the same section of law. The previous sentence clearly states that the school district precincts are to be arranged according to population as equally as possible.

The attached amendment will actually become Section 1 of the bill. It is to change from 33 to 60 days before an election the candidate filing deadline for a school district election. This is to provide the same filing deadline as exists for all other elections and matches the changes included in several other election related bills introduced this session.
