Minutes:

Chairman Belter opened the hearing on HCR 3057.

**Representative Wrangham:** I think the title pretty much sums it up. What we're asking here is the study of some possible tax incentives which would be linked directly to the employment of payroll employments in ND. Most if not all States are doing some things to encourage economic development and businesses to locate in our State and this resolution studies incentives which encourage employment in ND. This resolution is targeted to encourage new and current employers to employ within ND to economic development.

**Representative Vig:** Does this include entrepreneurs as well?

**Representative Wrangham:** I am very sure it would. The study can go into many different areas and the idea was included in here to specify employers who are self employed as long as they employ other people.

**Representative Froseth:** This looks familiar. Has this resolution been introduced as a study resolution previously? And this is a directive here, the Legislative Counsel to study it.

**Representative Wrangham:** Not to my knowledge and when I asked for this to be drawn, it did take a while and they did some research. They had not indicated that to me.

**Chairman Belter:** The way this language reads, the Counsel still has the option of whether to study this or not.

**Representative Froseth:** I think the way this reads is directing them to do the study and I think they have to do it.

**Chairman Belter:** I think there's an out for them...

**Representative Wrangham:** That was not necessarily my intent, I'm sure that this resolution would stand on its own whether we're to demand them this study or just give them the option.

**Chairman Belter:** Any other testimony in support? Any opposition? Any neutral? Ok, we'll close the hearing on HCR 3057.

The Chairman asked the Intern to call John Walstad to see if there's an out for them. The Intern reported that they said they put it on a list for them to do, but if they don't have time to do it, they don't do it.

**Chairman Belter:** So what are your wishes on 3057?

**Representative Froseth:** I move a Do Pass and Put it on the Consent Calendar.

**Representative Owens:** Second it.

**Chairman Belter:** Is there any discussion? If not, all of those in favor signify by saying aye.

The motion carries. Rep. Wrangham will carry the Bill.
