

Mr. Chairman and members of the committee, my name is Mike Ressler and I am the Deputy CIO at the Information Technology Department. I am here to indicate the Department's support for Senate Bill 2118.

Section 1:

Current legislation was never updated to reflect the records management reporting in the biennial report to be the responsibility of ITD versus the Office of Management and Budget.

Section 2:

ITD currently publishes an annual report and recommends we change this reporting from the biennial report to the ITD annual report. The addition of the records management will not impact the cost of the annual report.
