Al Jaeger: No, a district chair can also sign that.

Rep. Kasper: Do you want the telephone number on line 14 as well? You ask for the name and address but omitted telephone number.

Al Jaeger: We need to take a look at that. It is two different things. You can get on the ballot by petition or by endorsement. Can we take a look at that and get back at you?

Rep. Kasper: I also want to make sure if that is supposed to be state chairman instead of district chairman on line 10.

Al Jaeger: We will double check that. The one thing with these laws here is that it narrows the section.

Rep. Haas: 16.1-11-06 relates to state candidate petition or political party endorsements require an entity on the ballot.

Rep. Kasper: But the state chairman does not sign the legislative petitions.

Rep. Haas: This section of the code doesn't relate to that.

Rep. Haas: Rep. Kasper had raised a question about this and Secretary Jaeger took it back and provided us with an amendment. We actually have two amendments for this bill. One that Secretary Jaeger had attached to his testimony yesterday, then the amendment that I passed out for you this morning.

Rep. Potter: Page 3 line 5 after 'follows', your suggestion is that we put in 1 and 2, and leave a after that? I take it we leave whatever is there?

Rep. Haas: That is exactly right.

Rep. Kasper: On page 3. It says any candidate for an office shall present a certificate of endorsement signed by the district chairman of any legally recognized political party containing the candidates name, post office, and telephone number. The above language says you shall present and in here we are adding telephone number. That tells me that if you do not present the telephone number you have not complied with the law as a candidate. Some people may not have a telephone number.

Rep. Karls: Candidates should.

Rep. Kasper: But they may not. Maybe they decided not to have a phone number. We just cancelled our home phone line.

Rep. Potter: I cannot imagine a candidate for any office not being willing to have their telephone number out there for people to call them. If you don't want people to call you don't run for office.

Section 6, page 4, line 2: Shortens title of office of State Representative for ballot



TESTIMONY TO THE HOUSE GVA COMMITTEE

REGARDING SENATE BILL 2234

Chairman Haas and members of the House GVA Committee:

The North Dakota Association of Counties (NDACo) submits this testimony in support of Senate Bill 2234.

Senate Bill 2234 amends section 16.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code to add telephone numbers to candidate contact information, adds a ballot name and candidate certification to the candidate's affidavit, and allows counties the option of using electronic pollbooks.

Adding the telephone number to the contact information for a candidate provides county and state election administrators one more option for quick contact of a candidate. The addition of the candidate certification clarifies it is the candidate's responsibility to verify eligibility for candidacy. The Senate did amend the bill to include a space for writing out the ballot name requested, just above the candidate's signature on the affidavit.

In its final section, Senate Bill 2234 provides counties the option of using an electronic pollbook in lieu of paper at the polling site.

The North Dakota Association of Counties appreciates your consideration and requests a Do Pass recommendation on Senate Bill 2234.
