Chairman, members of the committee:

For the record, I am Lawrence Hopkins, Deputy Treasurer for the Office of State Treasurer. I am here in support of House Bill 1126 relating to the transfer of oil and gas gross production tax and oil extraction tax revenues.

The State Auditor's Office has asked that we clarify the language of 57-51.1-07.3

Under the current manner in which this distribution is being made the Oil and Gas Research fund receives 2% of the "states share" up to three million dollars. The General Fund receives a full seventy-one million dollars and the remaining amount is deposited into the Permanent Oil Tax Trust Fund. Because this section of the law uses the words "state share" the auditor's office felt there may be some question as to whether the two percent share deposited into the Oil and Gas Research Fund should be funded from the seventy-one million dollar General Fund share rather than in addition to it.

The proposed language makes it clear that Oil and Gas Research funds are deposited independent of the General Fund portion and allows our office to continue making the distribution in the same manner that is currently being used.

There is no fiscal note attached to this bill.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1126

- Page 1, line 1, after "Act" insert "to create and enact a new section to Senate Bill No. 2184, as approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly, to declare that bill to be an emergency measure;"
- Page 1, line 2, after "Code" insert "and section 2 of Senate Bill No. 2184, as approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly" and after "revenues" insert "and the effective date of Senate Bill No. 2184, as approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly; and to declare an emergency"
- Page 1, after line 17, insert:
 - "SECTION 2. Section 2 of Senate Bill No. 2184, as approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly, is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for taxable events occurring after June April 30, 2009.
 - **SECTION 3.** A new section to Senate Bill No. 2184, as approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly, is created and enacted as follows:
 - **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
 - **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** Sections 2 and 3 of this Act are declared to be emergency measures."
