HB1164 Testimony – Support of HB1164

Madam Chair, members of the committee:

For the record, I am Lawrence Hopkins, Deputy Treasurer for the Office of State Treasurer. I am here in support of House Bill 1164 relating to the transfer of oil extraction tax revenues.

Oil extraction tax revenue is distributed to six different state funds and has been distributed monthly for at least the last six years and probably since its inception. Our office noted that section 57-51.1-07 states the funds will be apportioned quarterly. In order that we may continue under our current operating procedures we are requesting that the timing of the oil extraction tax distribution be change from quarterly to monthly.

There is no fiscal note attached to this bill.
