Bruce Engelhardt, Director, Water Development Division State Water Commission: See testimony 1. 2:33

Rep. Keiser: Is there any purpose to be served by adding a legislator from that area since we do set the policy for the state?

Bruce Engelhardt: I guess that would be up to the legislature, its nothing certainly in the bill that prevents one of the appointees from being a legislature or more than one.

Rep. Brabandt: Basically this bill combines 2 committees into 1 as it stands?

Bruce Engelhardt:: Correct

Rep. Hofstad: The title relates to compensation, is there any compensation for this board?

Bruce Engelhardt: I am not sure. I believe that was from the original title and there is nothing in the bill regarding compensation.

Rep. Hofstad: The repeal section I presume is taking that other board and combining them, is that right?

Bruce Engelhardt: Correct

Rep. Nathe: Is Minnesota or Manitoba currently represented on any one of those two committees?

Bruce Engelhardt: They are represented on the committee that was formed by the executive order.

Rep Porter: We can do a little bit of research, will have Kirby look that up and see when the boards are created it just follows normal state pay rate and normal state mileage rates available to the board. We'll have Kirby look that up unless someone else from the water commission has an answer, if they are paying any members to go to these meetings.

Rep. Keiser: If they are being paid as most of these boards appointed by the governor are, there probably should be a fiscal note on this bill.

Rep. Porter: Mr. Sando indicated that they are not being compensated and there is no compensation language that exists for this board. So I am sure there wouldn't be any legislators interested then.

Rep. Porter: Any other questions? Any other support in favor of HB 1060?

Joe Belford, Down Extreme Acceptance Coordinator for the Devils Lake Flood: (no written testimony) (6:37-7:35) I think in answer to your question that was asked about compensation. I think each organization that they represented is picking up the mileage tab for those attending meetings. I support the concept that has been proposed here today and we need to continue to have dialogue Manitoba water people.

Rep. Porter: Further testimony in support of HB 1060? Any opposition to HB 1060? We will close the hearing on HB 1060. Committee we have HB 1060 in front of us.

Rep Keiser: I move an amendment for discussion purposes that we amend the bill on page 2 line 23 adding a new subsection P and it would read one representative and one senator from the affected area appointed by legislative management.

Mr. Chairman and members of the Natural Resources Committee, my name is Bruce Engelhardt and I am the Director of the Water Development Division for the State Water Commission. On behalf of State Engineer, Todd Sando, I am here in support of House Bill No. 1060.

This bill will combine the two Devils Lake outlet advisory committees into a single advisory committee. It also removes the task of preparing an operating plan.

The original Devils Lake outlet management advisory committee was created when there was only one outlet planned at Devils Lake (the West End Outlet) and consisted of ten members. A second advisory committee was created by executive order when the East End Outlet was under construction. The two committees had their first joint meeting in early 2012 and have essentially been operating as a single committee.

House Bill No. 1060 combines the two committees and sets the membership at 15. This committee's membership will be similar to the two existing committees. The combined committees have been providing beneficial advice on the operation of the Devils Lake outlets and a forum for understanding and compromise between the Devils Lake Basin and downstream interests, as well as providing all interests the opportunity to participate in the discussion of recommended solutions. It is very important to have Minnesota and Manitoba represented on the committee to participate in these discussions and better understand the problems and solutions being implemented.

TESTIMONY ON ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1060

Mr. Chairman and members of the Natural Resources Committee, my name is Bruce Engelhardt and I am the Director of the Water Development Division for the State Water Commission. On behalf of State Engineer, Todd Sando, I am here in support of Engrossed House Bill No. 1060.

This bill will combine the two Devils Lake outlet advisory committees into a single advisory committee. It also removes the task of preparing an operating plan.

The original Devils Lake outlet management advisory committee was created when there was only one outlet planned at Devils Lake (the West End Outlet) and consisted of ten members. A second advisory committee was created by executive order when the East End Outlet was under construction. The two committees had their first joint meeting in early 2012 and have essentially been operating as a single committee.

Engrossed House Bill No. 1060 combines the two committees and sets the membership at 17. This committee's membership will be similar to the two existing committees consisting of the Governor or his designee, 14 members appointed by the Governor with equal representation of the Devils Lake Basin and downstream interests, and "[a] member of the house and a member of the senate who represent the Devils Lake basin region appointed by the chairman of the legislative management." I request that this language (lines 23 and 24, page 2) be amended to "A member of the house and a member of the senate, one representing the Devils Lake basin region and one representing the downstream region, appointed by the chairman of the legislative management." A great deal of thought and effort went into balancing the interests represented on the outlet management committee to ensure that the advice provided by the committee would consider both the Devils Lake basin and the downstream waters, it is critical that this balance be maintained.

I also request that on page 3, line 31, the word "nine" be changed to "ten" and the word "fifteen" be changed to "seventeen" resulting in the following sentence: "Any recommendations developed by the committee must receive support from ten of the seventeen members of the committee before submission to the governor or state water commission."

The combined committees have been providing valuable advice on the operation of the Devils Lake outlets and a forum for understanding and compromise between the Devils Lake Basin and downstream interests, as well as providing all interests the opportunity to participate in the discussion of recommended solutions. It is very important to have Minnesota and Manitoba represented on the committee to participate in these discussions and better understand the problems and solutions being implemented.
