Senate Hearing SB 2058

Senator Schaible: Call meeting to order regarding SB 2058. All Senators present except Senator Davison is absent. Senator Rust will fulfill his duties.

Senator Rust: Mr. Chairman and committee. My name is Senator David Rust from District 2. I am here pinch hitting for Senator Davison who is introducing this bill. What it does is allows an REA, Rural Education Association, to receive and spend dollars especially for English Language learners and to employ personnel and that would be helpful where you are dealing with more than one district. It also allows to receive and expend public and private monies. Since this bill has been drafted, we have determined that there are some unintended consequences. This bill has the effect of equating IEA's with LEA's. That is not a very desirable thing. I am asking you to kill this bill.

Senator Schaible: Any questions? Senator Rust? If not. Thank You. I will read an email from Senator Davison. It says, "I am asking you to kill the SB 2058, a bill dealing with English Language Funding and Regional Educational Associations. The purpose of this bill was to allow the REA's to receive federal EL funding directly. After further discussion with the Federal Dept. of Education and DPI, to determine that Rea's would have to have the same statutory rights as local education agencies LEA's which isn't the intent of this bill and I do not support that. REA's have this with Federal Education Special North Dakota Century Code but it is different with federal departments with different requirements. I hope that clarifies." Any other testimony in favor of this bill? Any testimony in opposition of this bill? Any discussion?

Senator Schaible: Close hearing. Senator Rust motioned for a Do Not Pass. **Senator Oban** seconded motion.

Vote taken. All voted for Do Not Pass and 1 absent. 5-0. Senator Oban will carry. No further business. Meeting closed.
