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Chairman Owens, members of the House Education Committee - I am Stefanie Two Crow, Director of Educational Equity & Support for the Department of Public Instruction. I am here to provide testimony regarding HB 1027 – a bill to amend and reenact sections 15.1-02-15, 15.1-02-17, and 15.1-09-33.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to removal of references to the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 and replacing with the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015. HB 1027 is a housekeeping bill; amending this bill will assure the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction provides consistent language referencing the Every Student Succeeds Act regulations and no longer follows those eliminated under No Child Left Behind within these sections of the North Dakota Century Code.

The Every Student Succeeds Act was signed into law on December 10, 2015 and represents the national education law with a commitment to equal opportunity for all students. It reauthorized the 1965 Elementary and Secondary Education Act, which was previously reauthorized as No Child Left Behind. Currently, the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction is following the regulations enacted by the Every Student Succeeds Act within the North Dakota State Plan.

The North Dakota Department of Public Instruction asks for a recommend 'Do Pass' on HB 1027 as it will provide clear and consistent language under current education law.
