**Notice of Intent to  
Adopt and Amend Administrative Rules**

TAKE NOTICE that the Office of Attorney General, Fire Marshal Division will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Administrative Code 10-07-01 at 09:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 10, 2020, at 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND, in the Brynhild Haugland Room in the State Capitol Building. The purpose of the proposed amendments to the rules is to update language to comply with current state regulations and practices. The proposed amendments address the definition of State Fire Marshal and fire prevention rules. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the Office of Attorney General, Fire Marshal Division, 4205 State Street, Bismarck, ND 58503.
