## **FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES**

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Board of Medicine will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code title 50, at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, June 6, 2022, at the Board's Conference Room, located at 4204 Boulder Ridge Rd, Suite 220, Bismarck, ND 58503. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to provide clarification and remove outdated, redundant language. The proposed amendments address general board administration (article 50-01), physician licensure (article 50-02), physician assistant licensure (article 50-03), continuing medical education (article 50-04), and prescriptive practices (article 50-05).

The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the North Dakota Board of Medicine, 4204 Boulder Ridge Rd, Suite 260, Bismarck, ND 58503.
