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NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT, AMEND OR REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Board of Nursing will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments of North Dakota Administrative Code Title 54. The hearing will be:

The proposed amendment of the following Title 54 Board of Nursing:

- Article 54-01 General Administration
- Article 54-02 Nurse Licensure
- Article 54-03.2 Standards for Nursing Education Programs
- Article 54-04.1 Nursing Education Loans
- Article 54-05 Standards of Practice
- Article 54-07 Unlicensed Assistive Person
- Article 54-09 Workplace Impairment Program Repeal

The purpose of the amendment is to update the Title 54 to be consistent with the revisions to the NDCC Nurse Practices Act 43-12.1 and revisions to NDCC Occupational and Professional Licensing 43-51-02. The proposed amendments are not anticipated to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in this rulemaking action.
