Code 61-02-01-01 Permit Required at 9:30 AM on Wednesday, January 9, 2013, at Wingate by Wyndam 4429 19th Ave SE in Fargo, ND 58103.

The purpose of the proposed rule addition to 61-02-01-01 is to accommodate and facilitate pharmaceutical services in Long-term care facilities. The proposed rule 61-02-01-01 addition addresses the desire to incorporate automatic dispensing machine technology into nursing facilities.

The proposed rule is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
