NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Occupational Therapy Practice will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code 55.5-02 and 55.5-03 at 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 10, 2013, in the Ft. Totten Room of the North Dakota State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to update and clarify the rules governing occupational therapy practice. The proposed amendments address application for licensure, renewal of licensure, continued competency, supervision, and scope of practice. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the Board of Occupational Therapy Practice at 2900 East Broadway Avenue, Suite 3, PO Box 4005, Bismarck, ND 58502-4005. A copy of the proposed rules may be requested by writing the above address or calling (701)-250-0847. Written comments on the proposed rules sent to the above address or telephone number and received by October 20, 2013, will be fully considered.
