NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES RELATING TO N.D. ADMIN. CODE CHAPTER 75-08-01 VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Human Services will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code chapter 75-08-01 at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 8, 2022, in Bismarck, N.D. in Room 210, located on the second floor of the Judicial Wing of the State Capitol.

The proposed changes are as follows:

Section 75-08-01-01 is amended to change the definition of "qualified rehabilitation professional" to mean a vocational rehabilitation counselor that has obtained a baccalaureate degree in a field of study reasonably related to vocational rehabilitation and has indicated a level of competency and skill demonstrating basic preparation in a field of study that reasonably prepares the individual to work with consumer and employers. This change is being made to address staffing issues and maximize employment and retention options in staffing.

Section 75-08-01-37 is amended to fix a grammatical error.

The proposed amendments are not anticipated to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in this rulemaking action.
