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NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULE CHANGES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health (Department) will hold a public hearing to address proposed changes to North Dakota Administrative Code Chapter 33-44-01 ("Medical Marijuana") on April 8, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. (central time) in the Lewis and Clark Room, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota.

The purpose of the proposed administrative rule changes is to update rules to incorporate state law changes included in House Bill 1213 of the 67th Legislative Assembly regarding the definition of tetrahydrocannabinol (THC). In addition, rules will be updated to incorporate state law changed included in House Bill 1359 regarding designated caregivers. Proposed changes would also modify definitions, establish a new process for minor applications, require dispensaries to post Department materials, modify rendering materials for medical marijuana waste, modify written notifications, require information on ingredients used in formulating a medical cannabinoid product, clarify concentration information to be used on labels, require disclosure of extraction process on labels, not allow use of the word organic on labels, allow a laboratory to transport marijuana from a dispensary, remove batch label requirements, and modify failed batch lot requirements. The proposed changes include requirements to be complied with by the Department, manufacturing facilities, dispensaries, a laboratory contracted with by the Department, and agents. The proposed rules are not expected to impact the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
