NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Administrative Code chapter 33-06-05, School Immunization Requirements. The hearing will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, May 13, 2013, in Room 212, Judicial Wing, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to change the school immunization requirements. The amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in these rulemaking actions.

The proposed amendments may be reviewed at the Division of Disease Control, 2635 East Main, P.O. Box 5520, Bismarck, ND 58506-5520. A copy of the proposed amendments may be requested by writing the above address or calling 701-328-2378. Written or oral comments on the proposed amendments sent to the above address or phone number and received by May 24, 2013 will be fully considered.
