NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Health will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Administrative Code sections 33-31-03-07, 33-33-01-07, 33-33-02-07, 33-33-03-02, 33-33-06-18, 33-33-07-01, 33-33-08-01, 33-39-02-01, 33-41-01-10, and 33-42-01-10. The hearing will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 31, 2013, in Room 212, Judicial Wing, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to change license fees for salvaged food operators, mobile home parks, trailer parks and campgrounds, vending machines, bed and breakfast facilities, beverages, food establishments, lodging establishments, body art establishments, and tanning facilities. The amendments will impact the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. No taking of real property is involved in these rulemaking actions.
