NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will hold a public hearing to address a proposed new N.D. Admin. Code Article 37-13 Commercial Driver Training School Requirements and a proposed new N.D. Admin. Code Article 37-14 Lifetime CDL Disqualification Reinstatement, at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 6, 2015 in Room 206, of the Department of Transportation Building, 608 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. The hearing will begin at 10:00 a.m. and will continue until 11:30 a.m. or until no further testimony is offered, whichever occurs first.

The proposed new Article 37-13 is to prescribe rules and regulations concerning the administration and enforcement of commercial driver training schools.

The purpose of the proposed new chapters, 37-13-01 Definitions, 37-13-02 Commercial Driver Training School Requirements, 37-13-03 Driver Training Vehicle Requirements, 37-13-04 Commercial Driver Training Instructor Requirements, 37-13-05 Driver Training Instruction Requirements, and 37-13-06 Refusal, Suspension, or Revocation of License, to Article 37-13 of N.D. Admin. Code are to specifically describe the requirements for operating a commercial driving school and the requirements for driver training instructors.

The proposed new Article 37-14 is to prescribe rules concerning the reinstatement of driving privileges for drivers who have lifetime commercial driver's license disqualifications.

The purpose of the proposed new chapters, 37-14-01 Authority for Reinstatement and 37-14-02 Qualifications for Reinstatement, to Article 37-14 of N.D. Admin. Code are to specifically describe the authority and eligibility requirements for drivers applying for reinstatement of driving privileges who currently have a lifetime CDL disqualification.

The proposed rules are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
