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## FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO REPEAL AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES RELATING TO 67-19-01 ACCREDITATION: PROCEDURES, STANDARDS, AND CRITERIA

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction (NDDPI) will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendment and repeal of certain sections to N.D. Admin. Code 67-19-01 Accreditation: Procedures, Standards, and Criteria at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 8, 2016, in the Peace Garden Room, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to repeal certain obsolete rules and create a new section relating to a school review process as required in NDCC 15.1-06-06(1)(d). The proposed rulemaking implements bill number 1029, enacted during the sixty-second legislative session, concerning school approval requirements. The proposed amendment and repeal is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
