NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES
RELATING TO 67-09-01 APPROVAL FOR SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION ESTIMATED
TO COST MORE THAN FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction (NDDPI) will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to North Dakota Administrative Code 67-09-01, Approval for School Construction Estimated to Cost more than Forty Thousand Dollars, at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 26, 2015, in the Ft. Union Room, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Department 201, Bismarck, ND, 58505-0440. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to implement statutes and amend agency rules. The proposed amendments relate to the approval of school construction approval requirements related to approval thresholds and reporting requirements. The proposed rulemaking implements Section 1 of HB 1426 and Section 1 of SB 2178 enacted during the most recent legislative session, concerning the threshold by which the Superintendent of Public Instruction is required to approve the construction, purchase, repair, improvement, modernization or renovation of any public school building or facility. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000 and there is no anticipated fiscal impact on the state.
