FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT, AMEND, REPEAL ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Education Standards and Practices Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments and adoptions to N.D. Administrative Code, 67.1-02-02, 67.1-02-02-02, Chapter 67.1-02-03, 67.1-02-03-05, 67.1-02-03-08, Chapter 67.1-02-04, 67.1-02-04-01, 67.1-02-04-02, and 67.1-02-04-04 at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, May 24, 2022, at 2718 Gateway Avenue, Suite 204, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed rules is to amend the kindergarten endorsement rules, to add career and technical education major equivalency rules, to add rules for substitute teachers, to add rules allowing a 40-day license out of country applicants and general edits for clarity.

The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
