## NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Addiction Counseling Examiners will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to rules in N.D. Admin. Code title 4.5 at 9:00 AM until 10:00 AM on Tuesday, March 25, 2014, at the Board of Addiction Counseling Examiners Office, 2900 E. Broadway Avenue, Suite 2, Bismarck, ND. The purpose of the proposed amendments is to establish requirements for licensure and special registration. The proposed amendments address the initial licensure and fees, clinical training program, and continuing education. The proposed amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of the Board of Addiction Counseling Examiners at 2900 East Broadway Avenue, Suite 3, PO Box 975, Bismarck, ND 58502-0975.
