NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
ADOPT AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES  
Relating to Pari-Mutuel Wagering Systems

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Racing Commission will hold a public hearing to address a proposed new rule and amendments to N.D. Admin. Code article 69.5-01-08 Pari-Mutuel Wagering Systems at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, January 6, 2014 at the ND Racing Commission Office, 500 North 9<sup>th</sup> Street (lower level), Bismarck, North Dakota.**

The purpose of the proposed rule and amendments are to amend and establish regulatory requirements and clarify rules. The proposed new rule and amendments implement a new wager type. The proposed rule and amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
