NOTICE OF INTENT TO
AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Private Investigative and Security Board will hold a public hearing to address proposed amendments to N.D. Admin. Code title 93 at 3 p.m central time, on Friday, March 15, 2013, at Office of the Attorney General, 17th Floor, Old Conference Room, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to implement statutes concerning private investigative and security services. The proposed amendment addresses qualified agents for security and investigative agencies, and increasing weapons fees by ten dollars. The proposed amendment is not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.

The proposed rules may be reviewed at the office of Assistant Attorney General Edward Erickson, Office of the Attorney General, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505-0040. A copy of the proposed rules and/or a regulatory analysis may be requested by writing the above address, emailing eerickso@nd.gov, or calling (701) 328-3536. Written or oral data, views, or arguments on the proposed rules sent to the above addresses or telephone number and received by March 29, 2013 will be fully considered.
