NOTICE OF INTENT TO
ADOPT AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES
Relating to Claiming Races

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Racing Commission will hold a public hearing to address a proposed new rules and amendments to N.D. Admin. Code article 69.5-01-07-17 Claiming Races at **9:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 27, 2017 at the ND Racing Commission Office, 500 North 9th Street (lower level), Bismarck, North Dakota.**

The purpose of the proposed rule and amendments are to amend and establish regulatory requirements and clarify rules related to claiming races. The proposed rule and amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
