NOTICE OF INTENT TO
ADOPT AND AMEND ADMINISTRATIVE RULES
Relating to Pari-Mutuel Wagering Systems and Simulcasting

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Racing Commission will hold a public hearing to address a proposed new rules and amendments to N.D. Admin. Code article 69.5-01-08 Pari-Mutuel Wagering Systems and 69.5-01-11 Simulcasting at **9:00 a.m. on Monday, November 2, 2015 at the North Dakota Racing Commission Office, 500 North 9th Street (lower level), Bismarck, North Dakota.**

The purpose of the proposed rules and amendments are to amend and establish regulatory requirements and clarify rules. The proposed new rules and amendments revise and adopt several sections of the Racing Commissioners International model rules regarding wagering and account deposit wagering as well as revise existing rules to increase effectiveness, account for modern wagering operations, and support regulatory oversight. The proposed rule and amendments are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000.
