## **Item Description**

**Enrollment** - Original 2001-03 biennium enrollment projections for Lake Region State College are:

**Tuition collections** - Budgeted tuition income for the 2001-02 fiscal year is \$925,133.

**Capital improvements** - The 2001 Legislative Assembly provided a capital assets appropriation of \$399,831 for the 2001-03 biennium, \$74,831 from the general fund for extraordinary repairs and \$325,000 from other funds, for the renovation of the college's front entrance.

**Workforce training** - The 2001 Legislative Assembly appropriated \$1,350,000 from the general fund for workforce training grants to be distributed to certain institutions of higher education, pursuant to North Dakota Century Code Chapter 52-08.

## Status/Result

Reported fall 2001 FTE enrollment was 627. Reported enrollment is higher than estimated due to a change in the method used to calculate enrollment. The new reporting method includes students served through distance and outreach education programs. Actual enrollment in other areas is consistent with original projections.

Actual tuition collections are anticipated to be consistent with budgeted tuition income.

Architectural plans for the front entrance project are being developed.

Lake Region State College was allocated \$271,880 of the \$1,350,000 appropriation. The college received \$140,631 of state workforce training funds during fiscal year 2002, leaving \$131,249 for distribution during fiscal year 2003.
