**Senate Bill No. 2380 - State Department of Health - Conference Committee Action**

The Conference Committee did not change the House amendment to provide appropriations from the community health trust fund of \$100,000 for funding the community health grant program advisory committee and \$250,000 for funding grants to cities and counties on a dollar-for-dollar matching basis. The Conference Committee added a continuing appropriation for the State Department of Health and public health units to accept gifts, grants or donations.
