

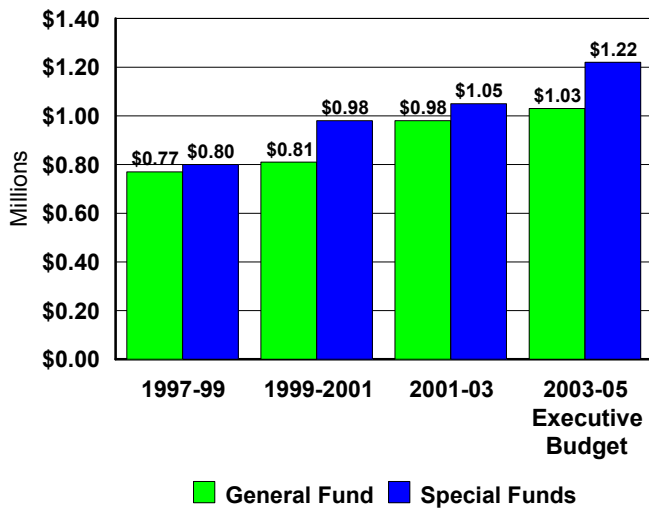

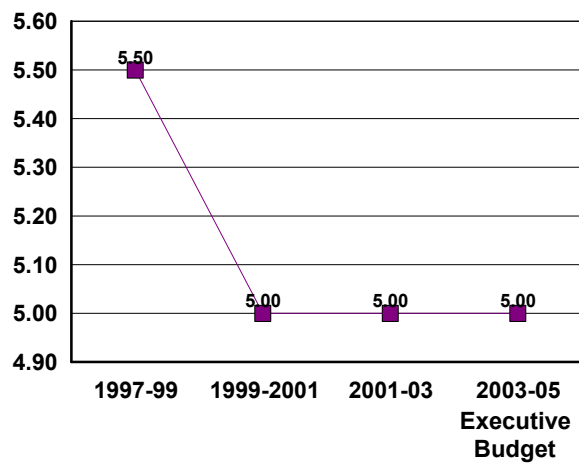

1. Increases grants line item to reflect anticipated federal funds available through the Challenge America Program. The House combined funding for the grants line item and the Lewis and Clark Bicentennial line item and decreased funding for grants by \$40,000 from the general fund.		\$65,800	\$65,800
2. Provides \$183,750 from the general fund for Lewis and Clark Bicentennial initiatives, an increase of \$8,802 from the 2001-03 biennium. The House combined funding for the grants line item and the Lewis and Clark Bicentennial line item and decreased funding for grants by \$40,000 from the general fund.	\$8,802		\$8,802
3. Provides a 7.9 percent increase in operating expenses line due to anticipated increase in biennial rent expense (\$13,476) and anticipated inflationary increases. The House decreased the operating expenses line item by \$3,000 from the general fund for removal of funding for two new computers.	(\$3,214)	\$19,622	\$16,408
